## JOG-A-THON

First year utilizing APEX as a coordinator. All donations were online, 58% of students received sponsorship. 80% of students were logged in and profiles created.

Stephanie Verna-her son liked the theme of level up.

The donations were a little confusing. The absence of Dewey Tiger was a noted. The kids liked the swag from sponsors. The shirts were functional. The cost of APEX was 50%.

Dewey was absent from the logos. Perhaps make the laps a bit bigger and do three sessions vs. two to not be so crowded.

An option for a longer trip would be nice. The time of the year is rough. It's a very busy time. There was a lot of pressure on kids in classrooms to get donations. Lots of kids who did not get prizes. The timing of the race was not distributed with adequate notice.

Student Government – Brady VP

Kinder does the logo for tshirts. There is a request for \$5 a shirt for 35 shirts. We need a formal request with a cost estimate. Forms can be found online on the PFO website. They have raised \$127 and will need a total of \$400. Once we have received a formal request we can put it to a motion for funding approval.

Student council would like to help with events coming up. We need helpers are the end

of the day to help set up during honor time. Help for Santa's night is December 12<sup>th</sup> and would be a good opportunity.

#### MEMBERSHIP – Ali

Membership drive has closed. Winning class is at Mrs. Ruswinkle at 104%. 151 paid memberships. They get an additional page in the yearbook. Staff and teachers were encouraged to join PFO if they are looking for PFO funding. 20 have joined this year, 12 are teachers.

#### FALL FESTIVAL – Bre

Committee meeting is 10/14 6pm at Starbucks. Ticket sales are a little low. 20 cars have volunteered for the trunk or treat. Candy donations look great. Cash sales on day of are very high. Food will run out. There are 40 teen volunteers and many cakes. 6<sup>th</sup> grade is selling water and sodas. Shane is doing popcorn. Sadie is getting prizes. Vehicles can be there at 3:45pm. Last recess is 2:45pm so we can start setting up.

#### FIELD TRIP STIPEND – Bre

Offering \$250 last year, but cuts were discussing amount set to \$150. Teachers would like a number for what we can provide for 2025-26. \$500 was provided per grade. We can raise our fundraising, or take from other areas that have already been covered. We have 19 classes to raise for, and we are looking for \$400 a class. \$7600 total.

Amount raised to \$400 a class was voted on unanimously and passed.

Crocker Art time slot visits will cost \$4,600 in November before Thanksgiving break.
